## What you need to know about Lung Cancer



Lung cancer is the second most common cancer in both men and women.



**50+**

90% Of lung cancer cases occur in people ages 50 and older

**155,870**

deaths from lung cancer each year



**Up to 25%**

of patients with lung cancers have no symptoms—the cancer is discovered through testing



More **MEN** die from lung cancer than from prostate and colon cancers combined.



More **WOMEN** die from lung cancer than from breast, ovarian, and uterine cancers combined.



**15% to 20%**

of all lung cancer cases in the United States are not related to smoking
