

How to Use Your Wixela™ Inhub™ Inhaler

Your clinician has prescribed medication that comes in a Wixela Inhub inhaler. It is important that you know how to use the Wixela Inhub device so that you can take your medication correctly and breathe better.

Important: Before using your Wixela Inhub inhaler for the first time, make sure 60 appears in the dose indicator window on the side of the device. This window shows the number of doses left in the inhaler. The device counts down by 1 each time you close the mouthpiece cover.

To use your Wixela™ Inhub™ Inhaler, complete these steps:



1. Hold your Wixela Inhub in one hand, and put the thumb of your other hand on the thumb grip.



2. Slide the thumb grip down until the mouthpiece appears.



3. Hold the inhaler level, with the yellow lever facing down and the mouthpiece facing you. **Important:** Do not block the air vents next to the mouthpiece cover.



4. Slide the yellow lever down to the end of the purple arrows. You will hear a click. The medicine is now ready for you to take.

Important: Keep your Wixela Inhub inhaler level. If it tips, you may lose the dose of medicine.



5. Hold the inhaler away from your face, and then breathe out completely to encourage maximal exhalation.

Important: Do not blow into the inhaler.



6. Place the mouthpiece between your lips, and then close your lips around the mouthpiece.

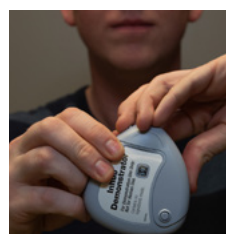
7. Take one long, steady, deep breath through your mouth and the inhaler. Breathe in fast and deep.



8. Remove the inhaler from between your lips.
9. Hold your breath for 10 seconds (or as long as you can).



10. Breathe out slowly.
11. Slide the cover back to the closed position. Closing the cover resets the inhaler for the next dose.



12. If your clinician has told you to take more than one dose, repeat steps 2-11.

13. Rinse your mouth with water, and then spit the water out. **Important:** Do not swallow the water.



When fewer than 9 doses remain in the Wixela Inhub device, the counter in the dose indicator window turns red to remind you to get a refill.

When you have inhaled the last dose in the Wixela Inhub device, the dose indicator window will show 0. Your inhaler is empty.

Dispose of your empty inhaler properly. Keep your Wixela Inhub inhaler and all medications out of the reach of children and pets.
